- informed and detailed knowledge about the subjects they intend to study
- an appreciation of the highly competitive selection process
- · a very accomplished personal statement
- excellent interview preparation
- · outstanding results.

Those students who have very high attainment at GCSE and aspire to Oxbridge and Russell Group universities or intend to submit an application to study courses in Medicine, Dentistry and Veterinary Science will be given specific support and guidance through our 'Proven Extra Potential' programme.

As part of this programme our students will receive the same first-class support and teaching that all of our students do, along with targeted opportunities which promote academic ambition and will encourage and guide our students to highly aspirational goals.

Enrichment Experiences

- The opportunity to obtain an additional qualification via the Extended Project
 Qualification (EPQ) a level 3 research-based qualification on a topic of your
 choice. This is very highly regarded by Oxbridge and Russell group universities.
- Subject specific initiatives e.g. Chemistry Olympiad, Biology Olympiad, Physics Olympiad, Business Young Enterprise Challenge, Auschwitz visit, Music competitions and performance opportunities, the Goethe Institut Debating Competition in German
- Guidance on gaining apposite work experience such as at Whitby Hospital and Whitby
 Doctors Surgery as well as James Cook Hospital. We also have links to the local vets
 and Whitby Wildlife Sanctuary, in addition to a yearly work experience placement with
 DEFRA.
- Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCS) distance-learning courses run online by many universities worldwide.
