10 schools in North Yorkshire have been partnered with a group of schools in the Hambantota region of Sri Lanka, on the South East coast of the country. WCC has begun a partnership with Beliatta Central College, an 11-19 school in Hambantota.

This is a really exciting project that all students are invited to become involved in. A group of students, the 'Global Schools Action Group' have been writing to and receiving letters from students in Sri Lanka and planning future projects between the two schools.

- To find ways to link the curriculum of Whitby Community College and Beliatta Central College

In September this year, Charith Danthanarayana who is the link teacher from Beliatta Central College will be spending a week in Whitby CC where he will work with teachers and students in planning joint curriculum projects and collecting resources to take back to Sri Lanka.
