

Revision Timetable, Summer 2008



This document shows a blank revision timetable for the 12 weeks from 7th April to the end of June. You will also be given an individual examination timetable.



Understanding the revision timetable

- The weeks are listed across the top of the sheets with each day of the week labelled.
- The hours are listed down the side of the sheets.
- Each small box covers a one-hour session.
- Each small box is divided by a diagonal line to give two ½ hour sessions.
- The greyed out boxes show the days and times when you are in College.

What to do with your revision timetable

- Decide on a code or a different colour for each of your subjects.
- Now mark on the dates and times when you have your examinations, using the codes or colours.
- Don't forget to mark on things like oral exams for French or German as these may not be shown on the printed examination timetable – ask your teacher for these dates.
- Now blank out any small boxes on the revision timetable for times when you know you are not available to revise. These might include times when you are:
 - Having meals
 - Travelling to and from College
 - Watching your favourite TV programme
 - Taking part in clubs and activities
 - Doing a part-time job
- Plan to do between 1 and 2 hours revision on days when you are in College, 5 hours over each weekend and 5 hours per day during holidays.
- For each day, decide on the hour-long sessions when you are going to revise.
- For each one-hour session decide which two subjects you are going to revise.
- Using your subject code or colour system, show which subjects you are going to do for each half-hour session.
- Make sure that you give a fair amount of time to each of your subjects.
- Give a little extra time to subjects as the date of that examination approaches.

Remember

- Coursework or homework takes priority over revision
- Try to set yourself realistic targets for the amount of revision you do
- Don't panic if you fail to meet your planned revision schedule exactly – use it as a guide rather than something that has to be followed to the letter.
